
Blue firepolished facettted beads 4 mm



The necklace step by step




34. Repeat step 2 to 28, then turn around for 180°, so that the side without 2-bead-stack is on the right. Go on with 29 to 32.




The necklace:



The bracelet

The bracelet is worked like the side parts, only the pattern is a little bit different and at one end you don't insert a faceted bead in the hole. My bracelet is 6 inch from the point where the clasp is attached to the beginning of the hole. The clasp is made with peyote stitch and is attached to the small end of the necklace.
