

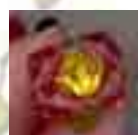













as a closure bead for a bracelet

Materials:



4 oder 6 mm Bicones / Swarovskis (4 green, 4 pink, 1 yellow)
Nylonthread (0,25 mm)

1. This:  is the middle of the thread. Take a pink bead to the left thread and two green to the right one, cross in the second green bead:		2. Take a pink bead to one thread and a green to the other, cross in the green bead:	
3. Repeat:		4. Go through the existing green bead, take a pink bead and cross in this pink bead:	
5. Go with one thread through all four pink beads, the other one goes through one – pull tight:		6. Take a yellow bead to one thread, go through two pink beads and again through the yellow bead:	

7. The second thread goes through the yellow bead in the opposite direction and then through the other two pink beads, again through the yellow bead:		8. Side view:	
9. Each thread goes through the green bead below it:		10. Knot both threads or go with them through another bead in the same direction if you want the rose bead to be a closure bead:	

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
